### **Residential Living**

CACS supports 12 individuals with developmental disabilities in two long-term care settings. Some of the individuals have called the residences in Terra Linda and Santa Venetia their home for over thirty years.

### **ADULT DAY SERVICES**

#### ***Income Opportunities Unlimited (IOU)***

Since 1995, IOU (formerly Adult Day Services or Adult Community Services – ACS) has offered adults with developmental disabilities opportunities for integrated education, work and community inclusion. CACS founded IOU with the belief that all people should be provided opportunities to generate income and that wage based employment is not always possible for everyone.

IOU assists people with disabilities to earn income through wage employment, microenterprise business ownership or membership in Keep Marin Green, a cooperative dedicated to reducing Marin's carbon footprint by picking up and recycling universal waste. Others may see people with disabilities, we see future business owners.

Currently, IOU supported businesses include Keep Marin Green Cooperative; Dusty's Puppets; Michael Valcour, a professional baritone; Scarlett's Vending Machine, Lupé's Vending Machine; Jon's Drinks; and Downtown Mia Brown's painting and artwork.

In addition to earning income, participants continue their education at local colleges or through adult education opportunities and engage in volunteerism. Through recreational opportunities in the community they maintain healthy lifestyles and make friends and connections.

#### ***Community Integration For Adults (CIFA)***

CIFA provides integrated education and community inclusion for adults with developmental disabilities who require additional support and flexible schedules due to therapeutic and medical needs.

Casa Allegra Community Services (CACS) is a non-profit agency that has been providing innovative support for people with disabilities and their families in Marin County and San Francisco since 1975. Casa Allegra was founded by CACS' Executive Director, Chris Bonfiglio and her friend Eileen Falvey, to support five children and teenagers with significant cognitive and physical challenges in their community. Casa Allegra is now 34 years old and in the past 12 months has assisted 50 adults with disabilities to live, work and participate in their community.

It is our belief that each person is entitled to live his or her life with dignity as a self-reliant and productive member of society. Our primary purpose is the provision of services that center around each individual's unique needs and that allow the person to live, go to school and work in environments and with a life-style that is typical for all people regardless of the severity of the disability.

We offer person centered planning, with individualized support, including support to the individual's family and friends.

## **LIVING SERVICES**

### ***Community Living Services (CLS, Supported Living)***

CLS supports adults with developmental disabilities to live safely and successfully where and with whom they choose on an ongoing basis; it may be in a shared house with friends or in an apartment, condo or townhome.

### ***Supported Living Services are about:***

- Visualizing dreams, NOT creating models
- Supporting people, NOT fixing or changing them
- Figuring things out together, NOT having the answers
- Change and evolution, NOT maintenance
- Letting go and shared power, NOT control
- Lives, NOT models and replication
- Focusing on gifts, NOT deficits
- The community and citizenship, NOT the path of clienthood, isolation, and disconnectedness
- Regular and ordinary, NOT specialized and professionalized
- Creation of gifts, NOT diagnosis of differences
- Standing by people, NOT conditional relationships
- Life and living as we all know and experience it
